

The project «Solidary Youth in Times of Crisis» was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Applicable to the Strand 2 – Measure 2.1 "Town-Twinning"

Participation: The project involved 53 citizens, notably 43 participants from Gazi Baba municipality, Macedonia and 10 participants from the Nova Gradiska town, Croatia.

Location/ Dates: The main event took place in Nova Gradiska, Croatia from 30 May - 1st June 2018.

Short description:

The day of 01/06/2018 was dedicated first, for welcoming speeches from the deputy mayor of the Nova Gradiska town and representative from Gazi Baba municipality. Also there was welcoming speech from the project leader of Mladiinfo International and the project partner Volunteer Center Slavonski Brod.

Afterwards, a short presentation was demonstrated by Mladiinfo International, Volunteer Centar Slavonski Brod and from the representative of the Crisis Management and Civic protection of Nova Gradiska.

The second part of the day was dedicated for sharing experiences from both of the sides, short speeches were held from representatives of the Gazi Baba municipality and the participants were included in the open discussions. Also, one of the volunteers from Macedonia had a presentation for Human architecture.

The last activity was a workshop "Step by step towards better crisis response" that involved all participants in creation of a small action plan that will help to better understand the role of each stakeholder and the volunteers in order to have better responding to natural disasters. The participants were divided in 4 groups and each of the groups worked on a different topic that is related to the crisis management.
